## Watercolors with Glue Art Project

This is a fun, easy watercolor project. The final paintings can look like stained glass windows.

### What you will need:

- pencil
- black paint
- bottle of glue
- heavy watercolor paper
- watercolor paints
- paintbrush

**1.** Use a pencil, and sketch a design on a piece of paper.

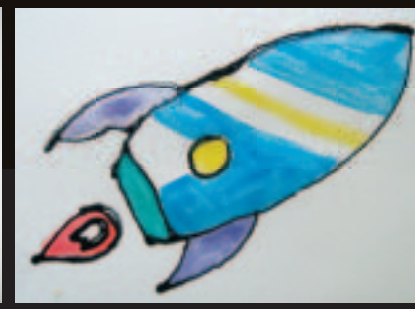
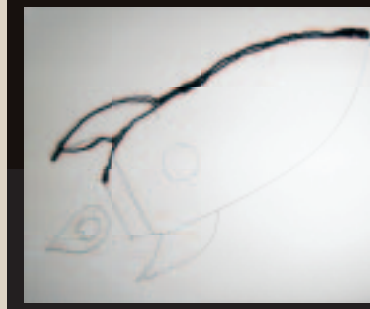
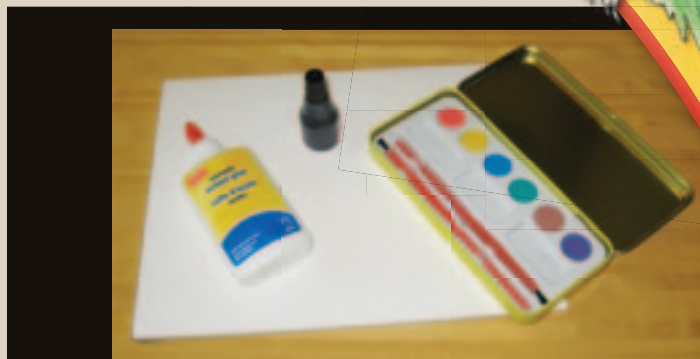
**2.** Mix a few drops of black paint into the bottle of glue. Stir the glue. If the glue bottle is full, you may need to take some of the glue out so you can mix the ink in it.

**3.** With the bottle of black glue, follow the pencil line. Don't worry if you don't follow the pencil lines exactly or if the glue line is wobbly; it will still look good.

**4.** When you are done with the black glue, set the paper aside to dry. If it's a nice day, put the paper outside. After 20 minutes, the glue should be dry.

**5.** Take out your watercolors and paint. Have fun! Be creative!

**6.** When you're done, let the paper dry. Then show your masterpiece to friends and family. And invite them to make a picture.
